

ORDINANCE NO. 14-107

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16.5 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT STOCKTON, TITLED PARKS AND RECREATION\*, BY INCORPORATING SECTION 16.5-6. DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS & REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the changes set forth would be in the best interest of the citizens of Fort Stockton.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT STOCKTON, TEXAS:

**CHAPTER 16.5 – PARKS AND RECREATION \***

Sec. 16.5-1. - Sec. 16.5-5. \*\*\*

**Sec. 16.5-6. Designated Parking Areas**

Designated Park Areas shall have designated paved parking locations. It is hereby prohibited for any vehicle to park on the grass or dirt outside of the designated paved parking areas. Any vehicle not complying with this ordinance is subject to citation and fine as allowed by City ordinances.

Section 16.5-6 shall not apply to any vehicle performing necessary maintenance where access requires it to park outside of paved parking areas or to vehicles allowed by a Special Event Permit issued by the City or County.

It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Fort Stockton that if any phrase, sentence, section, or paragraph of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionally or invalidity shall not affect any of the remainder of this ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation of the unconstitutional or invalid phrase, sentence, section or paragraph.

It is ordered and ordained that this ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as required by law.


