- 1. Discuss/Act upon Order 20-102(a) Extending & Amending the Limited Shelter in Place Order due to Public Health Emergency for the City of Fort Stockton.**

Mayor Alexander stated the following amendments were made:

Section 9, Item E- Added the wording it is also recommended that all employees having face to face contact with the public to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), which includes face masks, gloves, and other PPE appropriate to prevent spread of the virus. Right now this is a recommended practice, however, if supply is readily available it may become mandatory.

Section 9, J-1-Only one person will be allowed to enter an essential facility with the exception of assisting the elderly, disabled, and children.

Section 16- The First Amended Limited Shelter in Place shall remain in full force unless it is modified, amended, rescinded, or superseded by the Mayor and City Council.

Section 17: The First amended Limited Shelter In Place Order shall supersede the Limited Shelter in Placer Order due to Public Health Emergency issued on April 2, 2020 and shall take effect at 11:59pm Thursday, April 9, 2020.


