

NOTICE TO VENDORS

Notice is hereby given that the City of Fort Stockton is accepting sealed proposals for a 2-Year Service Agreement for Bulk Fuel, Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF), Coolant/ Anti-Freeze, Engine Oil, & Hydraulic Oil that shall be delivered to the City's Maintenance Yard and Current/New Landfill.

Proposals shall be directed to City Secretary Marina Cantu, City of Fort Stockton, P.O. Box 1000 or 121 W. Second Street, Fort Stockton, Texas, 79735. The deadline for receiving proposals is 10:00 a.m., Thursday, July 23, 2020 in the Office of the City Secretary at which time they will be opened publicly and read aloud. The approved and accepted proposal will be awarded at the Regular City Council Meeting scheduled for July 28, 2020 @ 5:30 P.M.

Delivery to 509 N. Valentine Street: Vendors must provide a proposal with bulk pricing that includes the actual fuel price plus fixed costs for fuel *i.e.* Unleaded Gasoline, Road (Green) Diesel, and Red Diesel, coolant/anti-freeze, engine (motor) oil, and hydraulic oil for fleet vehicles and heavy equipment.

Each Proposal Must Include:

- Two (2) 2000 Gallon Horizontal Fuel Tanks with a Containment System for Unleaded Gasoline & Road (Green) Diesel. Each tank shall include an Electric Calibrated Fuel Pump & Meter and a Visual or Dial Fuel Level Indicator;
- One (1) 250 Gallon Storage Tank with a Pump & Meter for the Diesel Exhaust Fluid (DEF); &
- Three (3) 275 Gallon Oil Tanks with Pumps & Meters for 5W 30 & 15W 40 Motor Oil, & Hydraulic Oil.
- One (1) 55 gallon barrel with pump for Coolant/Anti-freeze for all makes & models.

Delivery to 3400 Stone Road & 258 Moody Road: Vendors must provide a proposal with bulk pricing that includes the actual fuel price plus fixed costs for Red Diesel, coolant/anti-freeze, engine (motor) oil, and hydraulic oil for fleet vehicles and heavy equipment.

Each Proposal Must Include:

- One (1) 2000 Gallon Horizontal Fuel Tank with a Containment System for Red Diesel. Tank shall include an Electric Calibrated Fuel Pump & Meter and a Visual or Dial Fuel Level Indicator
- Four (4) 55 gallon barrels with pumps for 5W 30 & 15W 40 Motor Oils, Coolant/Anti-Freeze for all makes & models, & Hydraulic Oil.
